2. Revise, KEY INFORMATION SUMMARY SHEET (page 6), in the **Questions Due Date and Time** row,

Change ~~9/16/2013~~ to 10/01/2013

3. In Section 3.3.1 Transmittal Letter; revise the section to add the requirement to include the Offeror's Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN). The Section now reads:

3.3.1 Transmittal Letter

A transmittal letter shall accompany the Technical Proposal. The letter must be brief, shall be signed by an individual who is authorized to commit the Offeror to the services and requirements as stated in this RFP, and shall acknowledge the receipt of any addenda. The Offeror shall list its Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) in the transmittal letter. See Offeror's responsibilities in Section 1.22. Only one transmittal letter is needed and it does not need to be bound with the technical proposal.
