Questions and Answers #2

Question 29: In response to Section 3.13.1 Source Code Escrow, would GitHub or Team Foundation or equivalent solutions be considered acceptable solutions?

ANSWER 29: Yes, as long as MDOT’s requirements in Section 3.13.1 are being met, these are acceptable Source Code Escrow solutions.

Question 30: In Section 3.8.1 Roles and Responsibilities, Item F provides the following definition:

Key Personnel – A subset of TO Contractor Personnel whose departure during the performance period, will, in the State’s opinion, have a substantial negative impact on Task Order performance. Key Personnel proposed as part of the TO Proposal shall start as of TO Agreement issuance unless specified otherwise in this TORFP or the Offeror’s TO Technical Proposal. Key Personnel may be identified after Task Order award.

Could you please clarify the following sentence: Key Personnel may be identified after Task Order award. The following as noted below is how we’re interpreting this statement. Is this interpretation correct?

Are the “Key Personnel” from Item F the same “Key Personnel” resources identified as such in the staffing plan with specific names and an Appendix 4 resume as noted in Section 3.8.4 or are these considered other additional future “Key Personnel” that can be named and requested by MDOT SHA post award?

ANSWER 30: Section 3.8.4 requires that all four (4) Key Personnel must be available at the start of the task order. Key Personnel may be substituted after Task Order award, but only as allowed under Section 3.9.
